

**Use the following suggestions for formatting your own Imitating God cards or create your own questions:**

Tell about a time when someone talked to you or about you in a mean way. How did it make you feel?

Tell how you can use words to make someone feel good about themselves.

Tell about a time you were angry with a friend.

Tell about a time you were nice to someone you didn't really like.

A new student arrived at your school, or a new employee at your workplace. What will you say to him or her?

You just lost a soccer game. The other team played roughly, and you didn't think the referee was very good. What will you do?

Tell about a time when you told someone about what God means to you.

Describe a time when your actions imitated God.

Describe a poor choice that you wish you hadn't made.

You find \$20 on the floor of the hallway at school or at the office. What will you do?

You told Dad you were going to a friend's house, but went to the movies instead. A neighbor saw you there. What will you do?

Tell about a person at church who is kind to you.

Describe a time when you felt that God helped you make a good decision or a wise choice.

What is something you do during the week that might make other people think you are a Christian.

Describe a time when you were kind to a stranger.

Describe a time when telling the truth was difficult.

Tell about a time when you invited someone to church.

Tell about a time when you found it difficult to be a Christian.

What would you do if you heard friends talking rudely about another person or group of people?

Name a person you think is a good Christian disciple. Why?
