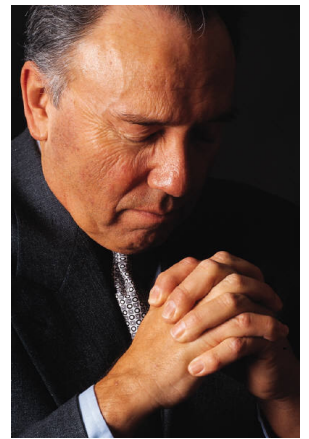


International Day of Prayer for Peace
